Diagnostic Imaging Reports Online via My Personal Records QA

What reports are available?

Reports for many types of tests or procedures will be available for you to view through MyHealth Records. You will be able to view the following types of reports:

- Computed Tomography (CT) scans
- Magnetic Resonance Imaging (MRI) scans
- Mammograms
- X-Rays of any part of the body
- Angiograms
- Injections into spine or joints
- Procedures using fluoroscopy (e.g. Needle guided biopsies)
- Gastrointestinal Series (an x-ray after you swallow a barium contrast)
- Ultrasounds
- Bone Density scans
- Nuclear imaging scans

Note: If you are expecting a report and do not see it, please contact your healthcare team if you have any questions. Please allow at least 7 working days from the time of your procedure before you ask your healthcare team.

When will all reports become available?

At this time, no date is set. Alberta Health continues to work with health care professionals to improve MyHealth Records so you can view more of your information. We will provide Albertans with an update, as more reports become available.

Can I add other reports to my MyHealth Records account?

You can upload your results into MyHealth Records. Please visit <u>Uploaded Files</u> in the Help Centre.

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What about Diagnostic Imaging reports for tests I had outside of Alberta? Are they uploaded to MyHealth Records?

Alberta Health does not have access to reports for tests that were completed outside Alberta. These reports have to be uploaded to MyHealth Records by you, the account user if you choose to.

When will my Diagnostic Imaging reports become available in MyHealth Records?

Usually, reports are available within 48 hours of the test completion. If you have not seen your report within seven days, it is reasonable to follow up with the health care provider who requested the test.

Who do I contact if I have questions about my results?

Please contact the health care provider who requested the test if you have questions about the content of the report. You may contact the MyHealth Records Contact Centre at 1-844-401-4016 if you have questions about how to view, print or upload a report or if you have other questions about how to use MyHealth Records.

How far back are my Diagnostic Imaging results available?

Diagnostic imaging reports are available for only 18 months from the date you sign up. No diagnostic imaging reports prior to March 2023 are available online.
