MyHealth.Alberta.ca Content

MyHealth.Alberta.ca Content Definition

“MHA Content” refers to purpose-oriented, current and evidenced based health information, images, videos, and audio files, that is free of preference or prejudice and complies with legislative, regulations, policies and operational processes.

MyHealth.Alberta.ca Content Criteria

Decisions for adding new content are made based on the following:

1) Content adheres to the MyHealth.Alberta.ca criteria for publishing new content (see Table 1).

Table 1: Primary criteria for new content on MyHealth.Alberta.ca

<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Developed by a recognized expert in the subject area and is clinically correct. The authorship is identified and has contact information clearly associated with the content.
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Evidence-based and current.
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Timely and reviewed every two years.
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Does not largely duplicate content currently available on the Healthwise® knowledgebase, but rather adds depth and breadth to a subject area.
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Applicable to an Alberta audience.
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Free of all bias including commercial bias.
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Reflects Alberta/Canadian standards, guidelines and practice.
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Will be reviewed by a health literacy specialist for plain language.

2) Comparative analysis with existing content on MyHealth.Alberta.ca (see Table 2 for example).

Timely Health Topics are updated each month and MyHealth.Alberta.ca will require a minimum of one month's advanced notice.
